- Mal.** (Mallets): Starts with a rest, then plays a series of eighth-note triplets starting at measure 6.
- Hp.** (Harp): Starts with a rest, then plays a series of eighth-note triplets starting at measure 6.
- Vln. I** (Violin I): Starts with a rest, then plays a series of eighth-note triplets starting at measure 6. Includes a dynamic marking of *mf*.
- Vln. II** (Violin II): Starts with a rest, then plays a series of eighth-note triplets starting at measure 6. Includes a dynamic marking of *mp*.
- Vla.** (Viola): Starts with a rest, then plays a series of eighth-note triplets starting at measure 6. Includes a dynamic marking of *f*.
